# Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time Year A

## *Reflection by Deacon Leo Howitz*

This Sunday's Gospel is a continuation of the parables of Jesus. Let us refresh our memory with the parable of the Sower from last week. Here we have a gardener or a farmer literally throwing seed everywhere; on the path, the rocky ground, around thorn bushes and some hitting the good soil.

The meaning of this parable is the seed represents the Word of God and how it is received by all people. It could be snatched away quickly from those who are hard of heart, this is the seed on the path. They listen to it, but do not understand and quickly forget it. It could be received with joy and soon forgotten, like the seed on rocky soil. Think of some people who go to weekend retreats, there the Spirit is fully alive, but it is only short lived. When they get home many find it difficult and soon go back to their old lives.

It could be received with joy and soon forgotten, like the seed around thorns. These people hear the Word, the Spirit is alive in them, but they are distracted by two things, the riches and anxieties of life. Jesus always warns us about this, do not be distracted by any worries and beware of the riches of life focus instead on the riches of Heaven.

It could be received with joy but not forgotten, like the seed on good soil. These people hear the Word with their hearts but also with their minds, and it makes sense. There is a solid connection between the heart and the mind, and this is what Jesus wants. He wants us to understand! We need the Wisdom of the Word to be felt emotionally in our hearts and intellectually with our mind through logic and reason.

So, in today's Gospel we have three parables. Are you ready to see what is coming next?

In the first parable, the devil sows his weeds in the field alongside the good wheat. This is the world we live in, there is good and evil living together and until the time of reaping it can be hard to tell which is which. We must deal with it because God is the farmer and will only separate at the time of the harvest

The next parable is about the smallest of seeds, the mustard seed. Is it the smallest seed? I don't know and it doesn't matter. People refer to something very small as a mustard seed, it is just a common term. Does it grow to be the biggest of trees? Not really, a mustard tree is more like a giant bush that looks very much like a big weed.

The last parable is about 'leaven' or yeast that is placed in flour to make a cake. And from the description 'three measures of wheat flour,' is a very large cake, about fifty pounds. But for this cake only a small amount of leaven was used, but the entire cake expanded from it, almost like magic leaven.

So, what do these stories mean? How are they connected? All three stories are descriptions of the Kingdom of God, and they are not as expected. In the first parable, it is a mixed bag, good and evil exist together until the final judgement. The mustard seed is more of a weed than a tree. And just like any weed, it is invasive, once it starts growing it is almost impossible to stop it. And the magical leaven, this is how God works, anything and everything is possible. So, even though you may have received the Word of God in good soil, you still need something else. Because nothing is as it seems, this is the Kingdom of God.

Beware of one thing! We live in a world that embraces evil very easily, we must always keep ourselves clean, and it is not easy. Even being grounded in the best soil, we can pick up on evil ways. We can get rid of these weeds in our own heart and we must. Use the Sacrament of confession and nourish your good soil with the Eucharist.

The Kingdom of God started very small, like a mustard seed and does not look very impressive, think of what it really was at the time of Jesus. There was a rabbi and twelve various men, some were even tax collectors and uneducated fisherman. Not a majestic Oak tree, more like an unruly wild but strong mustard tree.

Look at the Church today, the Pope, the bishops, the multitude of priests, the millions of believers. Jesus exists in each one of us and He is the leaven making the world rise and sing out in praise to God the Father.

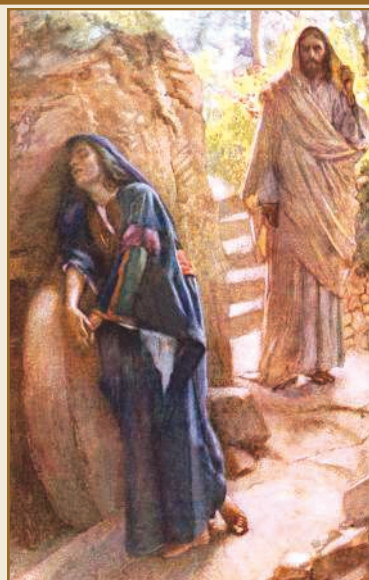

Brothers and sisters: The Spirit comes to the aid of our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes with inexpressible groanings. And the one who searches hearts knows what is the intention of the Spirit, because he intercedes for the holy ones according to God's will.

### GOSPEL:

[Matthew 13:24-43](#)

Jesus proposed another parable to the crowds, saying:

"The kingdom of heaven may be likened to a man who sowed good seed in his field. While everyone was asleep his enemy came and sowed weeds all through the wheat, and then went off. When the crop grew and bore fruit, the weeds appeared as well. The slaves of the householder came to him and said, 'Master, did you not sow good seed in your field? Where have the weeds come from?' He answered, 'An enemy has done this.' His slaves said to him, 'Do you want us to go and pull them up?' He replied, 'No, if you pull up the weeds you might uproot the wheat along with them. Let them grow together until harvest; then at harvest time I will say to the harvesters, "First collect the weeds and tie them in bundles for burning; but gather the wheat into my barn."'"

He proposed another parable to them. "The kingdom of heaven is like a mustard seed that a person took and sowed in a field. It is the smallest of all the seeds, yet when full-grown it is the largest of plants. It becomes a large bush, and the 'birds of the sky come and dwell in its branches.'"

He spoke to them another parable. "The kingdom of heaven is like yeast that a woman took and mixed with three measures of wheat flour until the whole batch was leavened."

All these things Jesus spoke to the crowds in parables. He spoke to them only in parables, to fulfill what had been said through the prophet: I will open my mouth in parables, I will announce what has lain hidden from the foundation of the world.

Then, dismissing the crowds, he went into the house. His disciples approached him and said, "Explain to us the parable of the weeds in the field." He said in reply, "He who sows good seed is the Son of Man, the field is the world, the good seed the children of the kingdom. The weeds are the children of the evil one, and the enemy who sows them is the devil. The harvest is the end of the age, and the harvesters are angels. Just as weeds are collected and burned up with fire, so will it be at the end of the age. The Son of Man will send his angels, and they will collect out of his kingdom all who cause others to sin and all evildoers. They will throw them into the fiery furnace, where there will be wailing and grinding of teeth. Then the righteous will shine like the sun in the kingdom of their Father. Whoever has ears ought to hear."

**CREED:** I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible. I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son of God, born of the Father before all ages. God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father, through him all things were made. For us men and for our salvation, he came down from heaven.

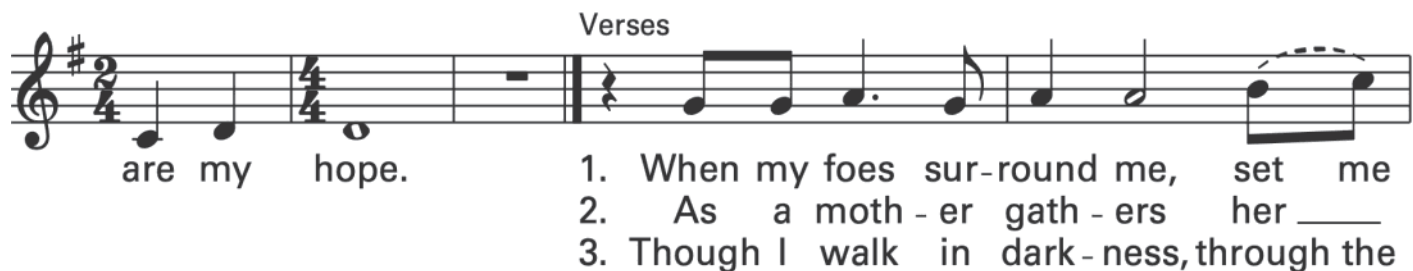

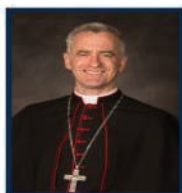
