## Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord: March 24, 2024

Jesus is for each of us, not only an extraordinary man who taught us to love and to give ourselves, but God himself who came to join us, in the smallest details of our lives to raise and help us experiencing his divine life. We have our branches in our hands. They are, somehow, today, a sign of our dignity that we have in being Christians. The blessing of being Christians must be translated in our life by our commitment to serve the Lord. Therefore, Palm Sunday helps us understand the joy of being Catholic Christians. For we are disciples of him who gave his life for us all so that we might have life.

The entry of Jesus into Jerusalem is a story that can be read in the four gospels! We understand that this event remained very present in the memory of the apostles and those who experienced it with them. It is like the beginning of the last stage of Jesus' life, a very warm welcome which will lead him to such a sad event. The Church, responding to a desire of Christian communities, wanted to give an important place to this story in the liturgy of Holy Week which begins with these words: "Today we begin the Great Week by evoking the entry of Jesus in Jerusalem, the Holy City."

The very first Palm Sunday procession, the one that is recounted in the gospels and that the liturgy reminds us of, brought together a group of friends of Jesus and some pilgrims. It was to mark the entry into Jerusalem of their Master, to whom they were very attached and whose coming to the Holy City for Passover they highlighted. Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! If this welcome was a moment of triumph for Jesus, we can think that it was a brief and modest triumph, because it was immediately contested by the Jews.

Jesus was quickly arrested during the week and sentenced as a criminal. Yet, it was a painful, a horrible and shameful death. The fullness of glory will only become a reality for Jesus on the day of his entry into the heavenly Jerusalem, when the Father resurrects him on Easter morning. That day will be the true day of the true feast, the day of the definitive triumph of Jesus, Christ, and Son of God.

By participating in the procession, branch in hand, on this Sunday which opens Holy Week, we wanted to celebrate the One who, today, is the Lord of glory, the King of heaven and earth. But, even more than a liturgical gesture, what can best glorify the Lord is to make Him the Light and Joy of our life. Welcoming the Spirit of the Lord means accepting that it teaches us the attitude of the Servant that the prophet Isaiah makes us discover: the Servant who, every morning, allows himself to be awakened by the Word, who listens attentively with obedience to the Lord who comes to his aid; the Servant who listens and allows himself to be instructed and guided on the road that leads to the Kingdom.

We will return home with blessed palm branches. These branches will remind us that we sang: "Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!" They must also remind us that Jesus needs us. Seized by the anguish of death, he wanted his family to remain with him under the olive trees of Gethsemane. It is the same call that he addresses to us today. So yes, may these branches taken into our homes be the sign of our commitment to the Lord.

Throughout this Holy Week, we are invited to immerse ourselves in prayer with the Lord. By participating in all the celebrations during this Holy Week, such as Holy Thursday night, Good Friday and Easter Vigil, you will respond to your discipleship call to be Jesus' Family who stand with him and by him in Gethsemane. Let us start the journey to Calvary with Him, so together we can go to the tomb to sing the song of victory. I am looking forward to seeing many of you at church this week to continue to renew in us the life of Jesus as one family.

Happy Holy Week to you all!

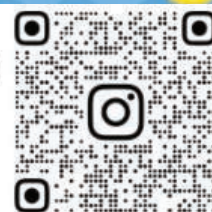

## St. Vincent Ferrer, Priest (1350-1419)

Vincent, born in 1350 in Valencia, Spain, to a Scottish nobleman and a Spanish mother, joined the Dominican order at eighteen and began teaching philosophy in Barcelona by twenty. Despite living amidst the turmoil of the 100 Year War and the Black Plague, Vincent embarked on a mission across Europe, preaching and converting thousands, even gaining the patronage of Pope Benedict XIII. After a divine vision urged him to evangelize, Vincent spent two decades traveling Europe, performing miracles, and converting multitudes, eventually becoming the patron saint of various laborers.

## **At the Procession with Palms—Gospel: Mark 11: 1-10**

When Jesus and his disciples drew near to Jerusalem, to Bethphage and Bethany at the Mount of Olives, he sent two of his disciples and said to them, “Go into the village opposite you, and immediately on entering it, you will find a colt tethered on which no one has ever sat. Untie it and bring it here. If anyone should say to you, ‘Why are you doing this?’ reply, ‘The Master has need of it and will send it back here at once.’” So they went off and found a colt tethered at a gate outside on the street, and they untied it. Some of the bystanders said to them, “What are you doing, untying the colt?” They answered them just as Jesus had told them to, and they permitted them to do it. So they brought the colt to Jesus and put their cloaks over it. And he sat on it. Many people spread their cloaks on the road, and others spread leafy branches that they had cut from the fields. Those preceding him as well as those following kept crying out: “Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Blessed is the kingdom of our father David that is to come! Hosanna in the highest!”

### **FIRST READING: Isaiah 50: 4-7**

The Lord GOD has given me a well-trained tongue, that I might know how to speak to the weary a word that will rouse them. Morning after morning he opens my ear that I may hear; and I have not rebelled, have not turned back. 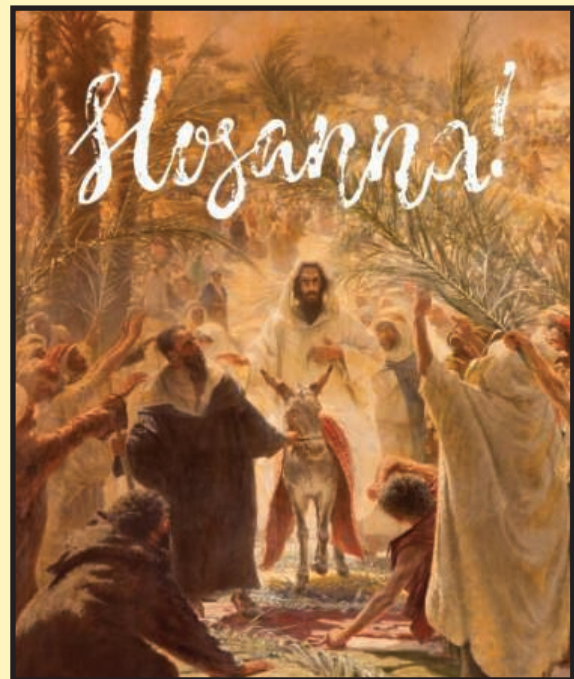

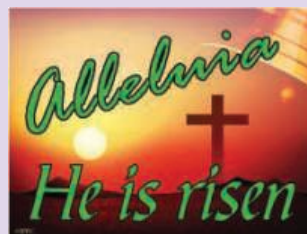
