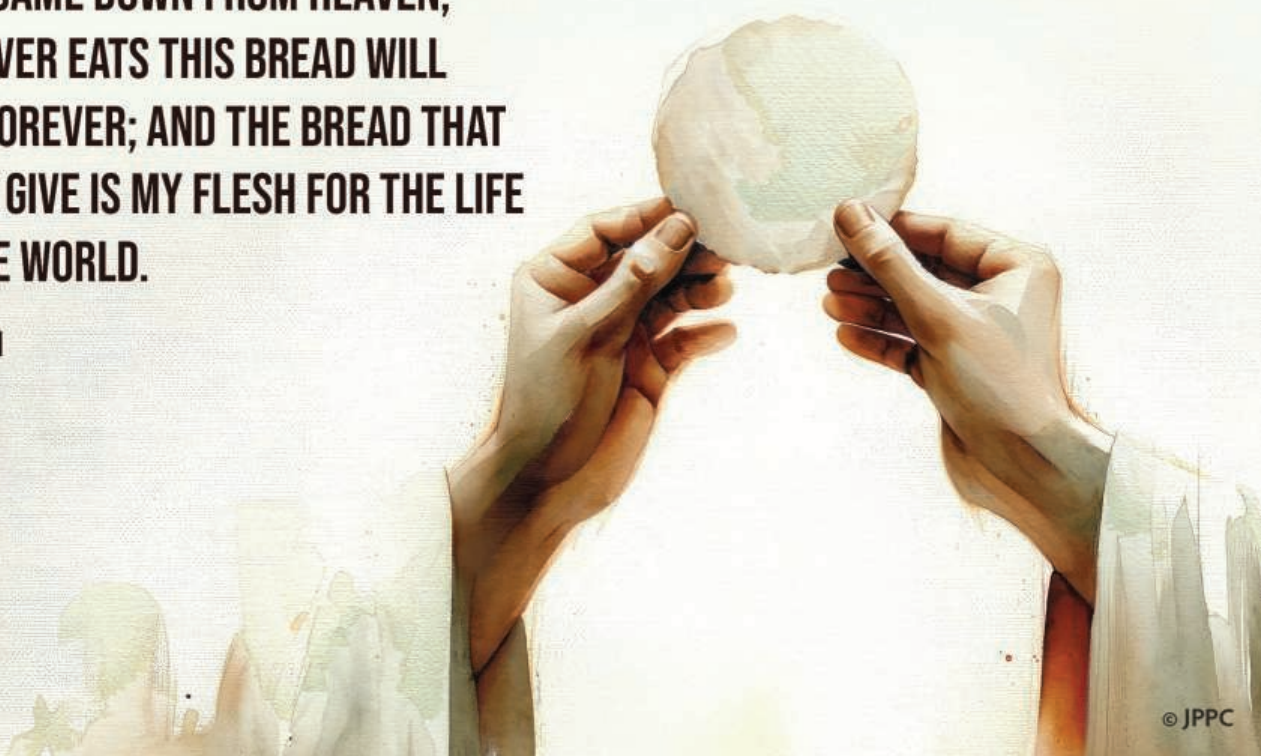

## Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time B

### Reflection:

In today's Gospel we continue with week three of the Bread of Life Discourse from the Gospel of John. The Bread of Life Discourse is broken down over five weeks. At the conclusion of these five weeks, we return to the Gospel of Mark for year B.

Jesus was a teacher and He used stories and examples that the Jewish people were already familiar with to plant the seeds of the Institution of the Eucharist. The Bread of Life Discourse is where it all started but the Institution of the Eucharist took many years to get it where we understand it today. I believe we have only touched the surface of understanding this mystery, but we know enough right now, and I am grateful just for knowing what we know.

The Exodus story is something all Jews hold near and dear to their hearts, so Jesus uses this story to teach the Jewish people. And the theme of the Exodus seems to reoccur throughout Scripture. Consider the first reading. It is a direct parallel to the Exodus story.

Elijah is going on a journey through the desert to Mount Horeb, which is another name for Mount Sinai, and this is the same mountain where Moses received the Ten Commandments. An Angel of the Lord gave Elijah miraculous bread from Heaven as food for the journey. The Israelites were given the Manna, miraculous bread. It took Elijah forty days and nights to reach this mountain, very similar to the Israelites who spent forty years in the desert.

In today's Gospel, right from the beginning there is mention of an Exodus reference. We read 'the Jews murmured.' Remember when the Israelites made their way into the desert, they 'murmured' against God and Moses because there was no food for them to eat. Here is the same thing happening. Jesus tells them He is the Bread that has come down from Heaven. They start to 'murmur' because they know Jesus and they know His mother and Father; it did not make sense to them. Jesus describes himself as the Bread of Life and compares himself to the Manna which the Israelites ate in the desert with one big difference.

**With the Bread that Jesus gives, it enables us to complete our own Exodus from this life to eternal life.**

To really bring home the point of this earthly Exodus, consider where the story of Jesus' ministry begins. Where was Jesus baptized? In the Jordan river by John and what is so significant about this? The Jordan River is where the first Exodus ended, what better place for the new Exodus to begin! Now comes the most important detail for each one of us: if you wish to be on this journey, you must do one very important thing. And that one thing is to believe Jesus did come down from Heaven to show us the way, kind of like a new Moses who will show us the way to the Father!

Believing is not just something you should take for granted. Remember what Jesus said in the Gospel, '*No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him.*' For this to happen God must pour out his grace upon you. If you are here right now in this Church reading this bulletin piece then the Holy Spirit is already working within you. The Father has drawn you to be part of His Holy people. What an amazing gift!

Think of how blessed you are because you believe that Jesus has come down from Heaven and He is going to lead us on our own Exodus through the challenges of this life to His heavenly Father. Mind you, He is also our heavenly Father and He loves us and accepts us the same as He does His own Son Jesus.

When you receive Communion today, thank Jesus, thank the Father. The full significance of the Eucharist is so far beyond our comprehension we cannot even begin to understand, but in the end Jesus will explain it all to us. It is a mystery which we all have the ability to fully understand, just not yet; but we will in the end!

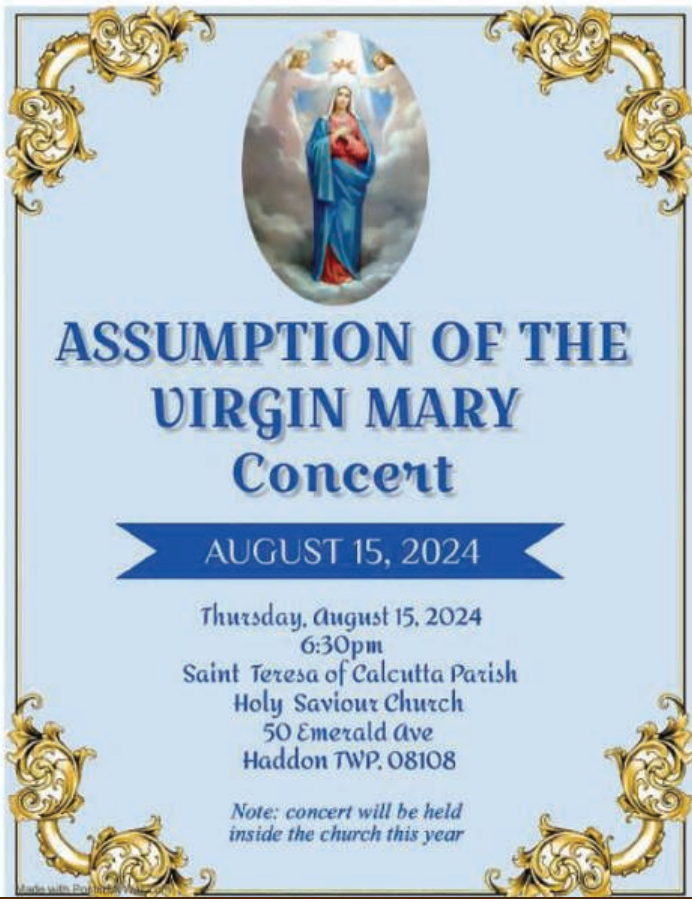
### SCHOOL BACKPACK DRIVE: Aug. 17-18

## St. Maximilian Kolbe

**Feast Day: August 14**

**Patron of amateur radio operators, drug addicts, political prisoners, families, journalists, and prisoners**

Many parents worry about their children's futures, but Maximilian Kolbe's story is unique. He prayed to the Virgin Mary, who appeared to him holding two crowns: one white for purity and one red for martyrdom. He chose both, marking a turning point in his life.

Maximilian entered the minor seminary of the Conventual Franciscans in Lviv (then Poland, now Ukraine) at 16, later earning doctorates in philosophy and theology. He also had a keen interest in science, even designing rocket ships. Ordained at 24, he founded the Militia of the Immaculate to combat religious indifference with prayer, work, and suffering. He also started the magazine Knight of the Immaculate and established Niepokalanow, a "City of the Immaculate," which housed 700 Franciscan brothers. He later founded a similar community in Nagasaki, Japan.

In 1939, during the Nazi invasion of Poland, Niepokalanow was bombed, and Kolbe and his friars were briefly arrested. In 1941, Kolbe was arrested again and sent to Auschwitz, where he volunteered to die in place of a fellow prisoner. He endured starvation and was eventually killed by a lethal injection. He was beatified in 1971 and canonized in 1982.

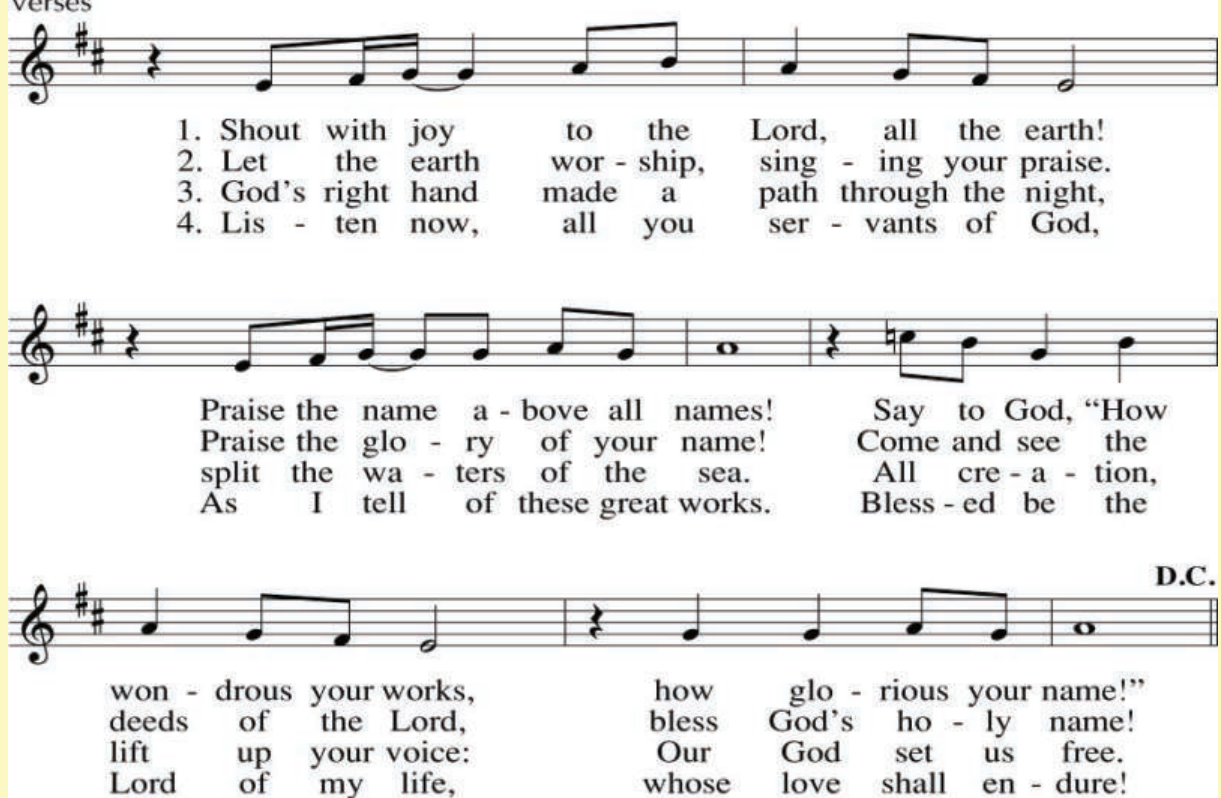

Elijah went a day's journey into the desert, until he came to a broom tree and sat beneath it. He prayed for death saying: "This is enough, O LORD! Take my life, for I am no better than my fathers." He lay down and fell asleep under the broom tree, but then an angel touched him and ordered him to get up and eat. Elijah looked and there at his head was a hearth cake and a jug of water. After he ate and drank, he lay down again, but the angel of the LORD came back a second time, touched him, and ordered, "Get up and eat, else the journey will be too long for you!" 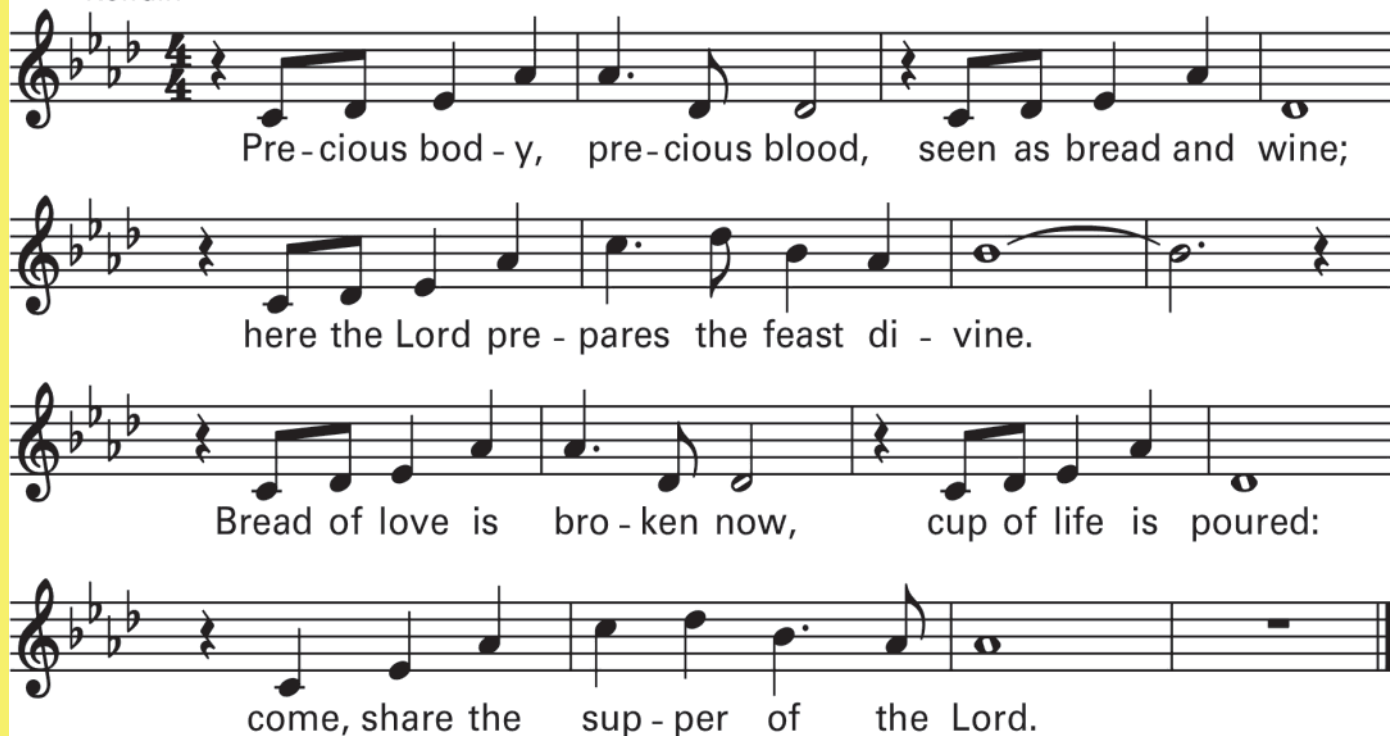

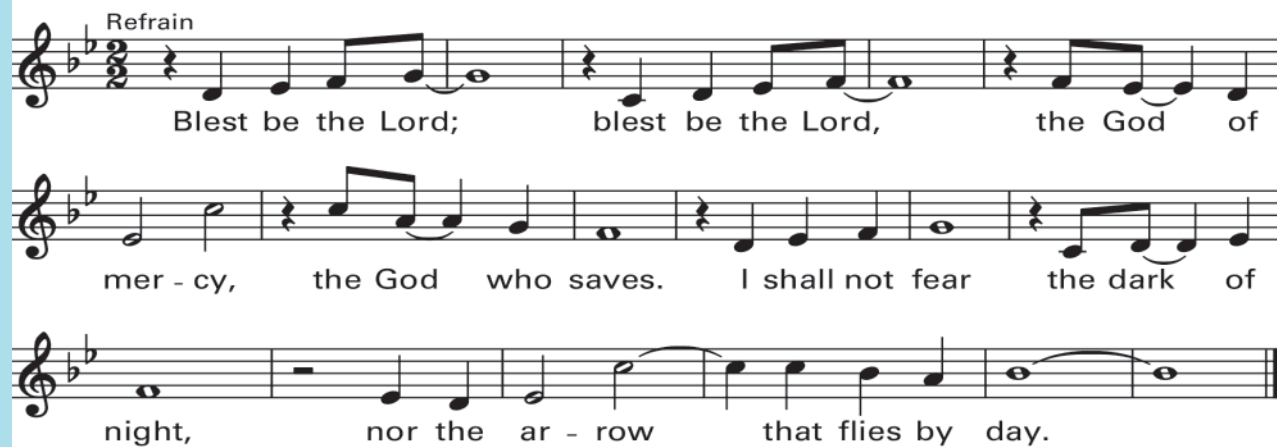

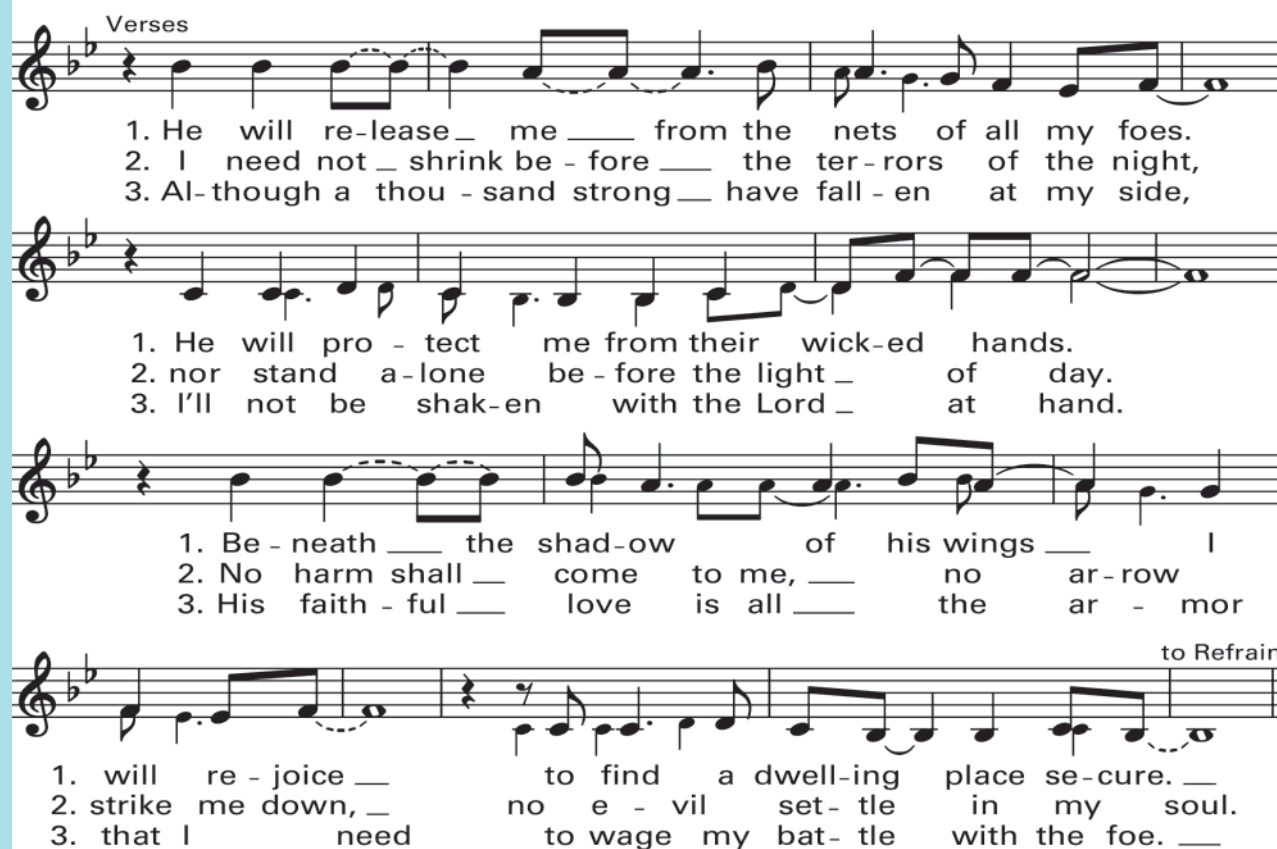
